

4. Action Week Against Racism (Race/Ethnicity)

Beneficiaries: General Public Awareness-raising
Country: Italy

Held on the International day for the elimination of racial discrimination, the Action Week Against Racism –organised by UNAR, the Italian National Office against Racial Discrimination – sees a number of civil society organisations collaborate on various activities aimed at promoting racial equality and combating discrimination.

5. Drachma (Religion & Sexual Orientation)

Beneficiaries: LGBT persons and their friends/relatives
Country: Malta

Drachma consists of a group of LGBT people who meet on a weekly basis to pray together and discuss LGBT issues within a Catholic context. Drachma also organises a monthly meeting with parents, relatives and friends of LGBT persons. Furthermore, Drachma has also organised public debates and awareness raising events focusing on LGBT issues and the Catholic faith, such as the public talks addressed by prominent personalities within the Catholic LGBT field.

6. FIABADAY (Disability)

Beneficiaries: General Public & Persons with a Disability
Country: Italy

FIABADAY, held yearly on the first Sunday of October is the National acknowledgment of one Day dedicated to the demolition of architectural features that deny access to persons with a disability. FIABADAY seeks to bring about cultural change through the belief that universal accessibility leads to a better quality of life for everybody. FIABADAY involves a collaborative effort between various NGOs, civil society organisations and other institutions to carry out 200 events across Italy.

6. FIABADAY (Diżabilità)

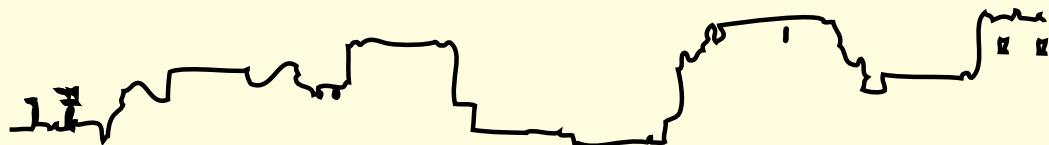

NGOs

The National Commission for the Promotion of Equality

(NCPE) is an autonomous, government funded body set up in January 2004 by virtue of Chapter 456 - Equality for Men and Women Act. NCPE's remit includes working to ensure that Maltese society is a society free from any form of discrimination based on:

- i) sex / gender and family responsibilities in employment, and
- ii) racial / ethnic origin and gender in the provision of goods and services and their supply.

Other functions include investigating complaints; monitoring gender/racial discriminatory advertising; research; awareness raising; dissemination of information.

Il-Kummissjoni Nazzjonali għall-Promozzjoni ta' l-Ugwaljanza

(NCPE) hija entità awtonoma ffinanzjata mill-gvern li twaqqfet f'Jannar 2004 skont il-Kapitolu 456 tal-Liġijiet ta' Malta - Att dwar l-Ugwaljanza għall-Irġiel u n-Nisa. - ii) razza / oriġini etnika u sess fil-provvediment ta' ogġetti u servizzi. Funzjonijiet oħra jinkludu l-investigazzjoni ta' lmenti; il-monitoraġġ ta' reklamar li jiddiskrimina bejn is-sessi/ir-razza; riċerka; qawmien ta' kuxjenza; tixrid ta' informazzjoni.

Voice for All

Voice for All VS/2007/0477 aims at empowering participants to challenge the learning and thinking processes which give rise to discrimination based on race, sexual orientation, gender, age, religion and disability discrimination and endorse diversity. Voice for All is a project funded by the European Community for Employment and Social Solidarity – PROGRESS (2007 – 2013). **Research:** The Voice for All transnational research study focuses on the six grounds of discrimination in Malta, Italy, Cyprus and Northern Ireland. The research works towards identifying and promoting any good practices being implemented to combat this discrimination and promote social inclusion and equality, throughout various areas of social life, including the education sector. NCPE is working in collaboration with the *Dipartimento Per le Pari Opportunità* (Italy); *SYMFILOSIS* (Cyprus); and the *Institute for Conflict Research* (Northern Ireland).
